St Stephen's Concert Series

Peter Krenske studied organ under the professorship of Naji Hakim and Marie-Louise Langlais in Paris. He has given more than 600 recitals in Australia, New Zealand, France, Switzerland, Germany, Italy, Slovenia, and Sweden, and performed as soloist with the Queensland Orchestra, Queensland Pops Orchestra, Queensland Philharmonic Orchestra, Melbourne Symphony Orchestra, and the Orchestra of the Bach Akademie, Switzerland. In 2009, Peter released his debut organ recording - a double CD set featuring works of Naji Hakim, and Franck's Three Chorals, recorded in Luxembourg. In November of the same year, Peter was appointed Cathedral Organist at St Stephens Cathedral, Brisbane. Upcoming engagements included major recitals in Luxembourg and Sweden.

In his first recital as Cathedral organist Peter Krenske traverses sonic territory previously unheard at St Stephen's. In fact some of it may not have heard in Cathedrals anywhere! These "first performances" include an Australian premiere by Paris organist Naji Hakim, some music from jazz greats, a bit of Bach, and Krenske himself! A wonderful "user-friendly" program which will surprise and delight all music lovers.
